NURTURING PARENTING PROGRAM – BIRTH PARENTS

NPP-PV is a 16-week program, typically done as a group process, though it can also be provided individually. Parents complete a pre- and post-test which is a self-report and helps to identify parenting beliefs and philosophy. The family participates in up to 7 parent coaching and parent-child observation sessions. A certificate is awarded upon completion of the program.

NPP-PV is a family-centered, trauma-informed curriculum for parents who have open intact or placement cases; and for pregnant or parenting teens who are currently in the care of DCFS. The focus of the program is to help strengthen positive interactions, healthy communication, family functioning, and the understanding of dynamics specific to nurturing parenting.
